


Sixth Grade Summer Reading Recommendations


Please note: These books are simply recommendations, listed in no particular order, for your convenience. We hope you will use these as a starting point to explore many new books together!




BOOKS WE WILL READ TOGETHER THIS YEAR


These titles should be avoided for summer reading, as they will be delivered with textbooks and read during the school year. We look forward to reading these together this year!








