Key Responsibilities

- 1. Maintain chart of accounts to support flexible and dynamic financial reporting.
- 2. Perform bank, credit card and balance sheet account reconciliations.
- 3. Manage fixed assets tracking system.
- 4. Prepare timely monthly financial statements for internal and external reporting.

5. Analyze financial results, including, but not limited to, budget to actual results, profit and loss activity, capital expenditures and cash flow management.

6. Work with Assistant Head of School for Business and Operations on preparation and analysis of annual budget.

7. Work with Assistant Head of School for Business and Operations on financial modeling and reforecasting throughout the year.

- 8. Support faculty with quarterly classroom and department budget to actual updates.
- 9. Manage preparation of documents and oversee requests for annual external audit.

10. Work with Development Department to reconcile contributions and track and report designated giving.

11. Prepare ad-hoc reports as needed.

12. Work with Parent Council Treasurer to ensure timely reporting and consolidation of all council activity.

13. Keep all financial plans and information confidential.
